

INFRASTRUCTURE REQUIRED

INFRASTRUCTURE:

✓ Requirement of Computer / AC etc., (All next generation Computers such as Core i3 / i5 / i7 with LCD Monitors).

A Category Towns : Minimum 15 Computers with UPS & AC 2 Nos B Category Towns : Minimum 10 Computers with UPS & AC 2 Nos C Category Towns : Minimum 05 Computers with UPS & AC 1 Nos

- ✓ One Laser Printer, Broadband Internet connection with wi-fi Router and Telephone is compulsory for all categories. All correspondence and reporting in the NICE network is through Internet / E-mail.
- ✓ At least in one Theory class room one 40 inch LCD TV should be installed which should be connected to a computer for ONLINE Teaching.

SPACE REQUIREMENT:

A Category Towns : 2000 Sq. Ft. Minimum.B Category Towns : 1500 Sq. Ft. Minimum.C Category Towns : 1000 Sq. Ft. Minimum.

Rooms: - Theory 2, Practical Lab 1, Reception cum Counseling 1, Centre Director Chamber 1.

It is compulsory for the Computer Lab to be Air Conditioned.

- ✓ It is advisable that the Reception cum Counseling Area is designed in such a manner that the Lab is visible.
- ✓ If the Reception cum Counseling Area can be Air Conditioned, then it will have a positive impact on the Students / Enquiries.
- ✓ A Generator / Emergency Inverter is advisable for power cuts.
- ✓ Theory Classrooms should be well ventilated.
- ✓ Toilet Facilities should be available.
- ✓ A sketch drawing of the Area may be provided so that we can advise a Interior plan.
- ✓ All the walls are painted in Light Grey Colour and all wooden work in Oxford Blue Colour. If sunmica is used then also it should be used in a combination Light Grey and Oxford Blue colours.

CHECK WHAT IS THE CATEGORY OF YOUR TOWN

HOW THE CATEGORY OF A PLACE IS DECIDED:

- <u>'A' Category Places</u>: State Capital, All District Head Quarters and all other Towns having population above 3 Lakh.
- <u>'B' Category Places</u>: All Other Small District Head Quarters which are not covered under 'A' category and other towns having population above 1 Lakh.
- 'C' Category Places: Semi Urban and Rural Places not covered under 'A' or 'B' category.

N.B.: The population of a place is calculated based on the data made available by the latest Census figures.
